On July 11, 2019, at 8:30 a.m. this Court held a show-cause hearing pursuant to Iowa Code section 665.7 following an Order for Rule to Show Cause entered May 29, 2019. The Plaintiff, Olympian LED, Inc. appeared through its attorney, Thomas D. Story. Defendant failed to appear.

Based upon the evidence presented, the Court finds beyond a reasonable doubt that the Defendant failed to appear for the Judgment Debtor's Examination previously scheduled for May 16, 2019 at 8:45 a.m. after being personally served with notice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, pursuant to Iowa Code section 630.11, Defendant is hereby held in contempt of court by failing to appear for said Judgment Debtor's Examination and it is hereby sentenced to pay a penalty of \$100 per-day, which penalty shall accrue on a rolling basis for 30 days or until Defendant appears for a Judgment Debtor's Examination, whichever shall be sooner.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant may purge itself of contempt by paying the above penalty or appearing for a Judgment Debtor's Examination.

Costs of this action are taxed against the Defendant.
